## CTAR Professor, Hector Valenzuela, PhD

2003 testified in Maui

- In 10 years concerns have increased
- Big question unintended consequences
- Late 2012 paper 54 of 86 cases traits with hidden DNA sequences inherent and viral and not studied consequences but not likely benign not reported to regulators.
- Transfer to aquatic organism of antibiotic resistance
- Classical breeding is not equivalent to biotech genetic engineering
- False: studies that show harm are invalid. Some studies do show evidence of harm
- Leg process: a minority of legislators did not promote constructive dialogue
- Anti 99-100 percent industry, professor/ researchers

#### **Uh law students:**

- GMO is Unconstitutional
- State to state must decide on GMO
- Legal issue of Severability
- Right to not be confused

## Lessons learned in 2013 leg. session:

- Messaging is important you either gain momentum or u get isolated
- Media Anti-GMO Goal for future is to make it difficult for them to dismiss them
- (Anti science anti progress you need to work on a farm). Message discipline
- Form or asymmetrical warfare. Corporate vs. grassroots
- Education is needed- especially in city of Honolulu
